Parent Consent Form for Reduction in class load for Senior-Status Students

A senior-status high school student may attend Craven County Schools for less than a full day pursuant to the following:

- (a) Full-day means four periods.
- (b) Schedule for a student taking two or more classes must have classes assigned back to back with no free period between classes.
- (c) All actions will be consistent with the principal's authority to grade and classify students.

A parent/guardian of the student must sign and return to the principal or designee the consent to reduction in class load for senior status students for the student to be permitted to take fewer than four instructional classes per semester.

Students may not be on school grounds earlier than fifteen minutes prior to the commencement of their first instructional class and later than fifteen minutes after the conclusion of the student's last instructional class. The student must leave the school grounds even if the student is scheduled to participate in an after school athletic program, club or other extra curricular activity later in the day. The student may return to school grounds fifteen minutes prior to the commencement of the after school athletic program, club or other extra curricular activity.

The school system will not provide transportation for the student to school or away from school other than at its usual and customary times. As a result, transportation to school will not be granted for students when their first instructional class is not first period. There will be not transportation away from school for students whose last instructional class is not fourth period.

Parents of students eighteen years of age or older who claim their children as dependents under section 152 of the Internal Revenue Code have rights to review the student's records under the relevant federal law. It is presumed that all parents of such students who are enrolled in this school system claim them as dependents unless pupils notify the principal and presents a verified true copy of parent's federal income tax return indicating that the parent did not claim the student as a dependent. Therefore, unless the student who is over eighteen years of age provides the information described above, the parent must sign the consent document described herein for the student over eighteen years of age to attend Craven County Schools for less than a full day.
